## TNFL01 - flygtrafik och flygtransporter

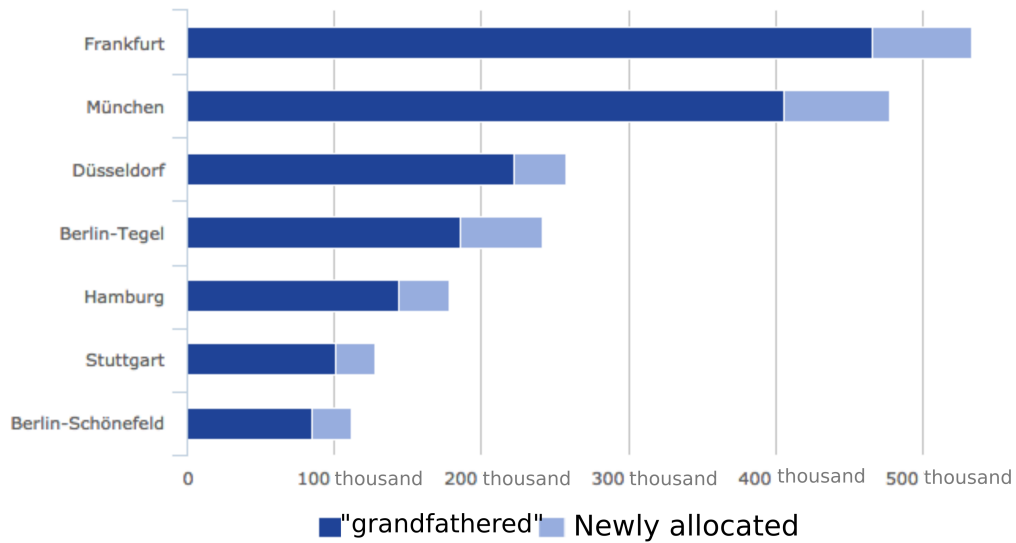


Figure 1: Allocated slots for arrivals and departures at German airports in the winter time table 2016/17 and summer time table 2017; “grandfathered” slots, that is, slots that are allocated to the same airline that did hold that slot before, are shown in dark blue, newly allocated slots in light blue. source: Flughafenkoordination der Bundesrepublik Deutschland.

**Lufthansa and Air Berlin** The airline Air Berlin had to file for bankruptcy in August 2017. Lufthansa wanted to take over parts of AirBerlin to extend its subsidiary company Eurowings. With a fast take-over of the Air Berlin flights Lufthansa aimed to avoid that slots are reallocated (for a time continuous operation was financed via a public sector loan from the German government). For all of Germany, Air Berlin (and their subsidiary Niki) held about 12% of all slots, in Berlin Tegel the share is 45.6%, in Düsseldorf 28.1%. Figure 1 shows the distribution of “grandfathered” and newly-allocated slots at large German airports.

Explain how slots are allocated at a level 3 airport, and then detail why a fast take-over of the AirBerlin flights would be beneficial for Eurowings/Lufthansa.
